The Goods and Services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our **basic services and overhead**. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

This list of services and merchandise does not include certain items that you may request we procure or pay for on your behalf such as clergy honorarium, certified copies, obituaries, etc. The prices for those items will be shown on the Funeral Services and Purchase Agreement Authorization describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Payment Information - Estate / Insurance

The financial policy of Spangler Mortuaries is that accounts be cared for in full at the time of arrangements. If we are required to bill an estate, the next of kin must acknowledge an estate/ late fee charge of \$300.00 and interest charges as well. The next of kin or person authorizing services will become personally responsible for payment in full of the account 6 months after the date of death. If we are requested to deal with insurance, proof of valid policy and an assignment must be received before services. If payment by insurance company is not received within 30 days, late fee and interest will apply.

	This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangement you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.) It includes a proportionate share of the business expenses (Occupancy, utilities, licensing, etc.) required to service the community on a 24 hour basis. Our charge includes but is not limited to consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, preparation of the death certificate and related documents.

CREMATION

Spangler Mortuaries is the ONLY NON CORPORATE mortuary in the South Bay Area with its own Crematorium, Wyant and Smith Crematory. Charges for the actual act of cremation isseparate. A price list for these services will be provided. All other firms MUST use anoutside 3rd party at a Cemetery. We will arrange for cremation at ANY facility you choose but additional transportation costs will apply.

Immediate Burial..... \$2,360 to \$17,315

Our charge for this service (without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director, transfer of remains to funeral home within 20 mile radius, sheltering of remains, placement in casket, local transportation to cemetery and all necessary authorizations (casket and filing fee not included).

Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser..... \$2,360

Immediate burial with casket selected from mortuary..... \$2,360 +Casket

Forwarding of Remains..... \$2,730

Our charge for this service (without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director, transfer of remains to funeral home within 20 mile radius, embalming, placement in casket and transportation to airport within 20 mile radius (casket, filing fee and airfare not included).

Receiving of Remains..... \$2,265

Our charge for this service (delivery to cemetery without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director, transportation of remains from airport and transportation to cemetery within 20 mile radius. No cash advance items i.e State re-filing fee, clergy honorarium or obituaries are included.

Direct Cremation..... \$2,360

Our charge for this service (without ceremony) includes basic services of funeral director, transfer of remains to funeral home within 20 mile radius, sheltering of remains for one day, transportation to Spangler Mortuaries owned, Wyant&Smith crematory in Sunnyvale AND THE BASIC CREMATION CHARGE (cremation requested and performed at other facilities requires additional transportation) and necessary authorizations (Alternative container/casket and filing fee not included).

With the exception of the SPANGLER MORTUARY OWNED, Wyant & Smith Crematory, the actual act of cremation is performed only at cemeteries. All cemetery cremation charges are subject to change by each individual cemetery. Spangler Mortuaries will arrange for cremation with any crematory the family requests.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without covering). The container we offer are cardboard containers. Cloth covered cardboard containers with handles and laminated fiberboard containers with handles are available by special order.
